Description
An after-school club for students in grades 3, 4, and 5 ... members develop environmental literacy as they work on several large, student-led projects throughout the year. Projects can include our school-wide recycling program, caring for our rainbow trout, and collaborating with other schools and local environmental programs. This year, the Environmental Club will learn about vermiculture (composting with worms!) and lead a new composting partnership with elementary students in Taiwan. Members become leaders in our school by sharing their environmental message through our blog, school announcements, and hall displays. In the past, members have partnered with students from other Maryland schools, and even presented at the Maryland Association of Environmental and Outdoor Educators conference.
