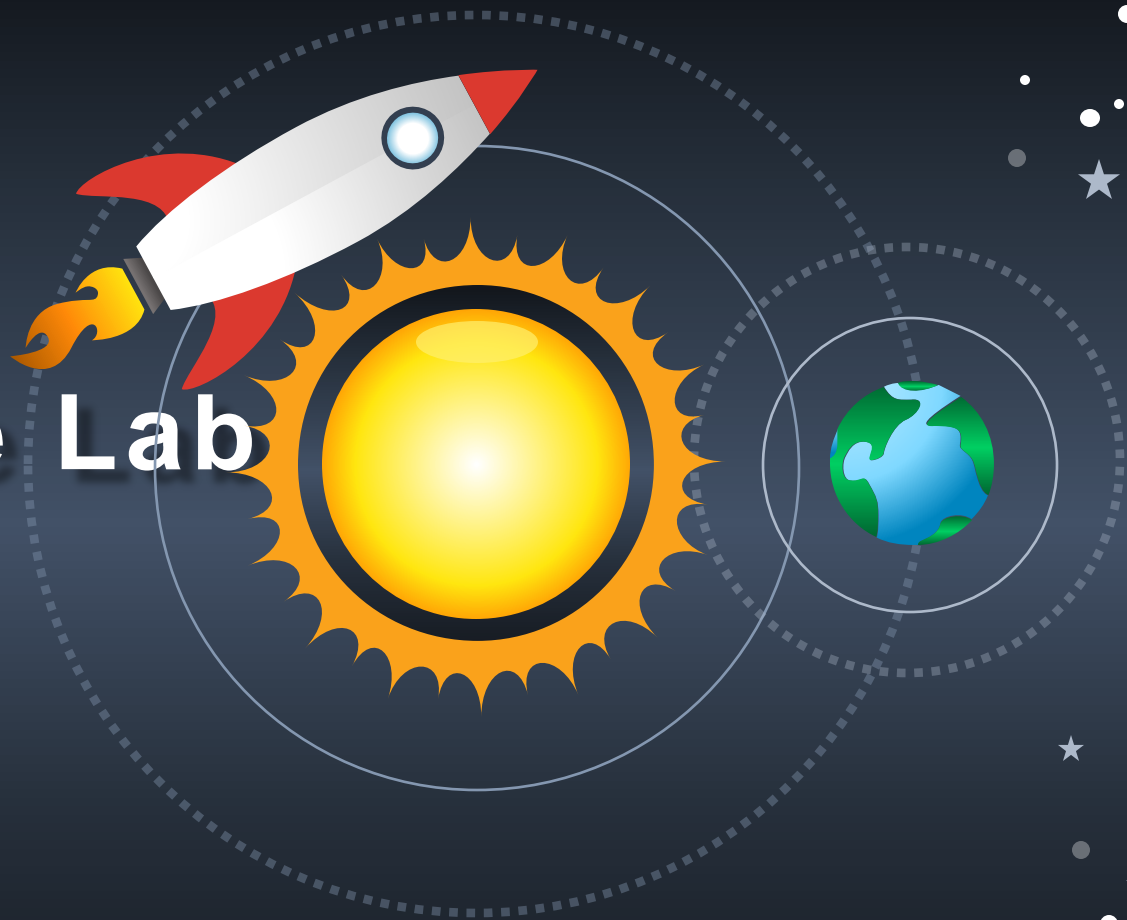


1 If the student visits the nurse's office, there is a 99% chance they they will be sent home.

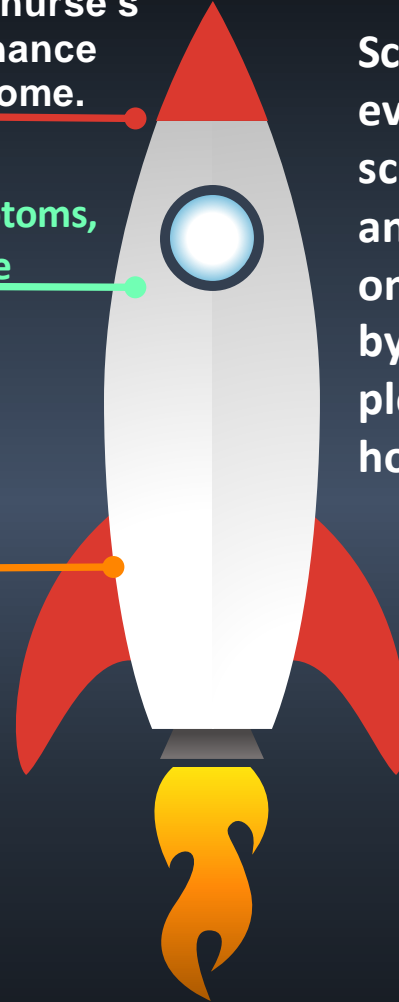

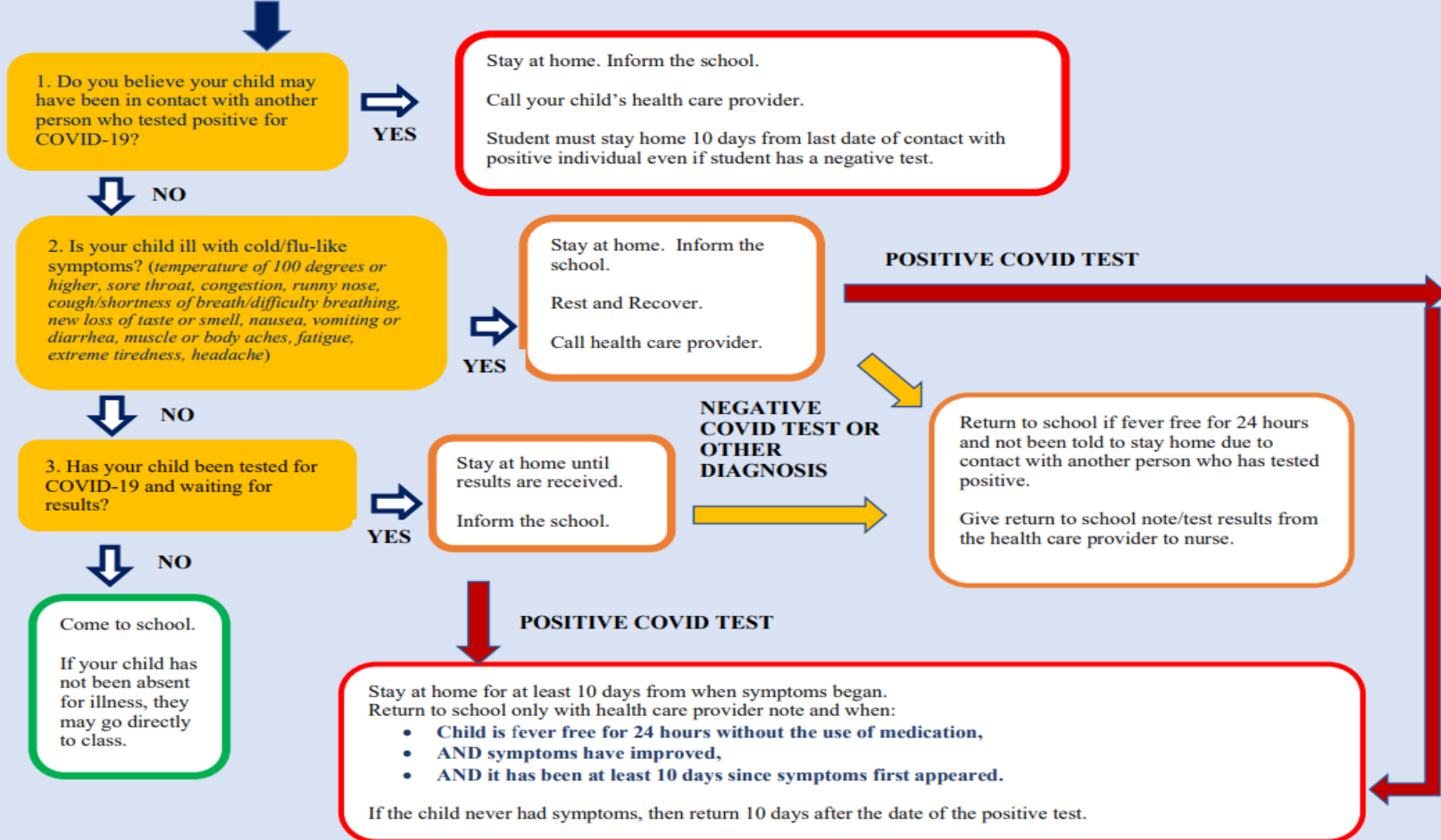
If your child receives daily medication the nurse will be visiting the classroom to administer it.
